4-year Bachelor's degree

Multiple exit/entry

Multidisciplinary

UG Degree Programme

Single Major with Minor:

- 3-year UG Programme
 - 120 credit out of which 60 credits in Major subject.
- 4-year UG Programme with Honours
 - 160 credits out of which 80 credit in Major subject.
 - With Research (12 credit) or without research

Duration and Multiple Entry/Exit

- UG Certificate
 - After completion of 1 year (40 credit)
 - Addl. 4 credits in work-based vocational course(s).
- UG Diploma
 - After 2 years (80 credit)
 - Addl. 4 credit in skill-based vocational course(s).

Duration and Multiple Entry/Exit

- 3-Year Bachelor Degree
 - After successful completion of three years (120 credit)
- 4-Year Bachelor Degree (Honours) (with or without Research)
 - After successful completion of three years (120 credit)
- ***Students will be permitted to take a break but the total years not to exceed 7 years.***

Programme Structure

- Semester: 90 working days
- Summer term:
 - 8 weeks during summer vacation
 - To be utilized for internship/apprenticeship/work-based vocational courses

Programme Structure

- Credit hours:
 - Workload measured in terms of credit hours.
 - One hour instruction per week over a duration of a semester (15 weeks)
 - One credit lecture/tutorial means one hour of engagement per week with a total of 15 weeks.
 - One credit practical/lab work means two hours.

Course Components

- **Lecture courses**
- **Tutorial courses**
- **Practicum/Laboratory work.**
- **Seminar**
- **Internship**
- **Studio**
- **Field projects**
- **Community engagement and services**

Curricular Components

- Major Stream Courses (50%) $4 \times 15 = 60 / 4 \times 20 = 80$ credit
- Minor Stream Courses ($4 \times 6 = 24$ credit / $4 \times 8 = 32$ credit)
- Multidisciplinary Courses ($3 \times 3 = 9$ credit)
 - Should be different from Major, Minor and MDC previously selected)
- Ability Enhancement Courses (English & MIL) ($3 + 3 + 2 = 8$ credit)

Curricular Components

- Skill Enhancement Courses (3x3=9 credit)
- Value Added Courses (2x4=8credit)
- Internship, Field Projects, Community engagement and services (2 credit)
- Research Project/Dissertation: 12 credit in VIII Semester in lieu of 3 courses.

Attendance

- **Minimum of 75%**

Assessment

- 100 marks for each courses; 75 Marks : End Semester Exam
- 25 Internal/Sessional
 - Internal Exam (Average of 2) : 12 Marks
 - Assignment/Seminar/Project, etc. : 8 Marks
 - Attendance : 5 Marks
- Attendance Mark:
 - **90+** : 5 Marks
 - **85 – 89** : 4 Marks
 - **80 – 84** : 3 Marks
 - **78 – 79** : 2 Marks
 - **75 – 77** : 1 Mark

Repeating, Re-evaluation

- If a student fails in a course (paper), he/she may repeat in the next semester
 - Can repeat only End Semester Exam
 - May change failed paper/course.
- If a student is not satisfied with his mark obtained, he/she shall submit application for reevaluation
 - within 15 days from date of declaration of results.
 - only for End-semester examination.

- Need to choose between English & Mizo

- One Minor Course (4 credit)
- One Multidisciplinary Course (MDC) (3 credit)
- One Value Added Course (VAC): Compulsory to all I Semester students but class to be divided into two Sections. (2 credit)
- One Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): MIL Eng/MIL Mizo (3 credit)

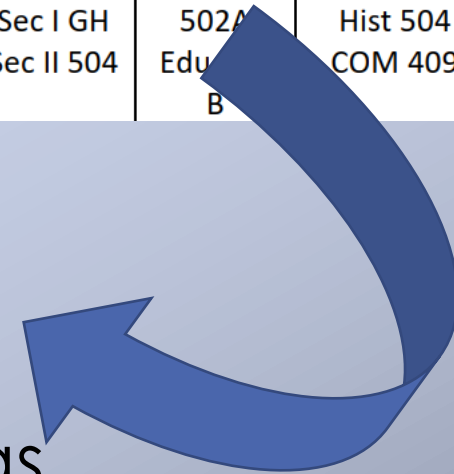
