The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Govt. Hrangbana College Aizawl was started in the year 1986 with only 50 student volunteers and two Programme Officers. Since inception, the NSS unit of the college has been involved in a variety of activities in the community within and outside Aizawl city.

The following are a brief report of the different activities of the NSS Units Govt. Hrangbana College for the period of 2021 to 2022.

A. REGULAR ACTIVITIES:

1. Orientation Programme cum Swachhta Pakhwada for NSS Volunteers:

14/08/2021: Orientation cum Swachhta Pakwada (Cleanliness Drive Programme) was conducted through online mode. Dr Zirliangura, State NSS Officer cum Deputy Secretary delivered a speech on Orientation for NSS Volunteers and Mr C Lalengkima, Assistant Professor St Xavier College Lengpui spoke on Swachhta Pakhwada. More than 350 volunteers presented in this programme.

2. Blood Donation:

1) 05-07/10/2021: Blood Donation Camp was organised with Civil Hospital, Aizawl at the College Golden Hall. A total number of 225 units of blood were donated (M-196, F-29).

2) 12/10/2021: Two unit of blood were donated at Civil Hospital, Aizawl.

3) 14-16/03/2022: Blood Donation Camp was organised with Civil Hospital, Aizawl at the College Golden Hall. A total number of 257 units of blood were donated (M-200, F-57).

4) 30-31/03/2022: Parallel Blood Donation Camp was organised at Civil Hospital, Aizawl and Synod Hospital, Durtlang. A total number of 121 units of blood were donated (M-80, F-41).

3. Cleanliness Drive

1) 30/10/2021: Cleanliness drive was conducted at Vaipuanpho. Vaipuanpho is one of the water sources of Greater Aizawl Water Supply Scheme. A total number of 50 volunteers (M-31, F-19) with two PO's were participated in this activity.

4. Observation and Participations of Important Days

- 1) RastraGhaan: As the Nation celebrates Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav by singing the National Anthem from 1st -13th August 2021, a total of 59 volunteers participated in this event.
- 2) 25th National Youth Festival 2022: Two (2) NSS PO and 5 Volunteers participated in the 25th National Youth Festival 2022 held on 12 & 13.01.2022 through virtual mode.
- 3) Observation of Constitutional Day: NSS Unit Govt Hrangbana College observed Constitutional Day on 26th November, 2021 at the college Golden Hall. In this programme Mr R Lalrinkima delivered a short speech on how India adopted the Constitution and it was followed by mass reading of Preamble to the Constitution of India. More than 40 members presented in this programme.
- 4) 11/09/2021: To celebrate Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, online Poster/Slogan Competition was organised. The theme was Value/Benefit of Independence obtained by India. A total number of 27 volunteers (M-13, F-14) participated in this competition.

B. SPECIAL CAMPING:

Under the theme 'Water Conservation' the NSS Unit, Govt. Hrangbana College organised three (3) Special Camping during the period as detail mentioned below:

1. 10-14/12/2021: Special Camping at Zathawma Bung Hmun, Samlukhai for 2 Units was organised under the guidance of two POs. The activity includes construction of Waiting-shed and awareness campaign on water conservation.
2. 16-21/03/2022: Special Camping at Chanmari Thanmual, Aizawl, two Units and 4 POs took part in this camp. The activity includes construction of Water Tanky and renovation of old asset i.e., public urinal at Chanmari Thanmual.
3. 21-26/04/2022: Special Camping at Muthi adopted village for 2 Units. The activity includes renovation of old assets (public urinals, waiting-sheds, incinerator, water reservoir etc). Volunteers also conducted cleanliness drive and they visited educational institution for awareness campaign on water conservation.

C. Construction of Assets:

1. 10-14/12/2021: Construction of Waiting-shed was undertaken during Special Camping at Zathawma Bung Hmun, Samlukhai.
2. 16-21/03/2022: Construction of Water Tanky for public urinal was undertaken during Special Camping at Chanmari Thanmual, Aizawl.

D. Other Activities:

1. 19/08/2021: Two POs C Lalhumbika and Dr Robert Lalremtluanga attended Meeting cum Briefing of NSS Officers of all institution within Mizoram.
2. NSS Unit GHBC contributed a sum of rupees 5,000 as NSS unit contribution for COVID Care Centre at R Dengthuama Hall, Mualpui.

3. 26/02/2022: Three volunteers (1.Hmingthanmawia Khiangte 2. Cicily Lalnunmawii 3.K Lalramnghaki) participated in 'Online Training on Human Rights' organised by Regional Directorate, Guwahati
4. Six NSS volunteers participated and submit their essay writings to commemoration of 75th India Independence Day celebration.
