garnered significant popularity within the city.



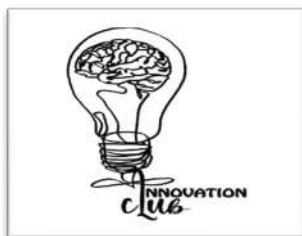
The event attracted students, adults from outside the college, and even prominent local journalists.

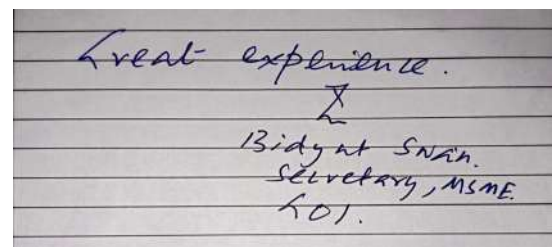


## 6) National SC ST Hub Conclave (15 October 2022):
