Innovation Club has been actively functioning since its formation. It consists of around 200 members and among these members; around 50 members actively participated in it.

The main objective of Innovation Club is to motivate the students in developing their ideas to start a business and also to drive the skills and imagination of students towards entrepreneurship.

In order to achieve the objectives, a number of activities were performed. Some of them are:-

- Personal Development Programme : Under IQAC, PDP was organized between 13th 26th Sept. 2017 and seven representative members of the club attended this programme and received a certificate.
- Seminar on intellectual property rights : Seminar on IPR was conducted under Universe Research Foundation at Hotel Floria on 29th Jan, 2018 and 10 representative members of the club participated in it.
- 3) Skills Development Programme : SDP was conducted under IQAC, GHBC between 10th 21st Feb, 2018 at GHBC conference hall. In this programme, a resource person was chosen by each club from GHBC and our club chooses Mr.F.Kapsanga, a successful entrepreneur and Mr. Lalhruaitluanga Asso. Prof Govt. Zirtiri Residential College and Managing Director of Zo Career Solution as a resource person. They each gave an enlighten speech to explore the minds and ideas of the students towards entrepreneurship and success in life. Questions and answers were exchanged and the students benefited a lot from it.

- 4) Mizoram Kailawn: A number of members of the club participated in the Business Plan Contest organised by Mizoram Kawilawn and among the winners, Lalrindika, 4th Sem, Commerce student was also selected.
- 5) 2-days Hackathon: The club participated in the 2-days Hackathon entrepreneur development camp at SIRD & PR, which was organised by MZU at Durtlang and won all the awards from 1st prize to 3rd prize.

6) STUDY TOUR

During an Even Semester, a Committee held among the OB of the Innovation Club and Dr Lalbiakzuali, have decided that a study tour was to be held before the end of the year. Then, necessary process was carried out and actions were taken right away. A member registration was opened and then after careful consideration on where the tour was to be conducted and what would be most helpful for the student, we, the in-charge have decided that Gangtok, Sikkim as our Destination.

And then there was a question on how to raised the fund for the tour, but with the knowledge and thoughtfulness of Dr Lalbiakzuali, we have decided to make a proposal to NEDP, in hopes that they might be able to sponsor the study tour. Then an organizing committee was formed to organize the programme of the tour. With their fast and impeccable work of the organizers, we were able to confirm who could participate among the members and we were also able to have a neat and firm programme planned for the tour in such a short period of time.

Then our proposal was submitted to NEDP. Fortunately, by the grace of God and thankfully to the kindness of the great worker of Planning Department our proposal was accepted and we were able to get the fund that we need and have a successful tour trip to our main destination, Gangtok, Sikkim.

The details report of Study tour are as under :

The period of Study tour cover 11 days from 24/May/2018 - 03/June/2018

1) Day-1 (24/May) : Aizawl - Silchar

We start journey from Aizawl and approach to Silchar via Vairengte by Sumo. At 11:00 a.m we left Aizawl from Govt. Hrangbana College and arrive Silchar at 6:00 p.m. After a little time spends in the train station we kept going by train at around 8:00 p.m from Silchar.

2) Day-2 (25/May) : Silchar – New Jalpalguri

After spending the whole night at train, we arrived Lamding at around 4:30 a.m. and NJP at 5:00 p.m. after going through the Station in Guwahati. We made booking of Tour Package in the NJP and make agreement with the Moonlight Hotel. We accommodate one night in the NJP at Moonlight Hotel.

3) Day-3(26/May) : NJP - Gangtok

We woke up early morning at around 4:30 a.m and approach Gangtok by the vehicles i.e 4 Sumo and 1 Car, provided by the package. Then, after 4 hours from NJP, we now arrive our destination land, Gangtok. We realized that the climate condition of Gangtok is so comfortable. We go through to our residency that is provided by Tour Package namely Tanishq Residency and turning up at 12:00 noon to have sightseeing to the six prominent and attractive Tourist Lodge in Gangtok like Bakthang Fall, Buddist Monustery, Sarvatra Dwar, Zeep lining, Plant Conservatory and Ganeshtok.

4) Day-4 (27/May) : Sightseeing

To refresh our physical and mental strength and to learn why Sikkim attract tourist, we plan to visit one of the most beautiful place in Sikkim like Tsongmo Lake and Mandir near the snow land. 5) Day – 5 (28/May) : VISITING INDUSTRIAL SIGHT


The main purpose for this tour is to visit Industrial site in Gangtok. But, there is only one Industry inside Gangtok, i.e Tripti's Industry/Enterprise. The details report are :-

➤ Introduction : Tripti's Enterprise is a business producing bakery products of around 200 items. It is the largest and biggest bakery producer at Gangtok, Sikkim and has evolved for 30 years.

➤ Qualification : Qualification is only necessary to the account officer and not to the workers. Workers are given training for one month and only the experienced workers are employed.

➤ Workers : The workers employed in the factory are only men and women are employed only for sale agent. There are 180 workers in the factory and their shop.

➤ Working hours : They work around eight hours per day and it can be reduced to four hours during winter season.

➤ Supply : Supplies are given to all over the city in Sikkim. They also have their personal shop near the factory and one in the MG Market, Gangtok.

➤ Export : They export their products to other city or state like West Bengal, Kalimpong etc... Exports in other state are to be expanded in future.

➤ **Import of machine** : The raw materials used in the factory are mostly imported from Mumbai and West Bengal. No problems are faced in running and maintenance of the machine and on electricity. They have an electrician and two Generators to support them.

➤ **Inventory** : The bread and cakes are produced daily to meet the order of all the agents and also to showcase some in their shop. The cakes for special occasions like Birthdays and Anniversaries are only produced according to the pre-order.

➤ Advertisement: Advertisement is only done in banner since their business famed all over the city. They do not use any social media and websites for advertisement but plans on using it in future.

➤ Auditing: Financial Audit is done quarterly by Government appointed Chartered Accountant.

> Profit and Loss: They incur profit of around 2 crore yearly and no loss is incurred.

Tax: They paid tax of around 16 lakh per month.

Auditor : They have their own auditor to audit the enterprise whenever they needed.

6) Day – 6 (29/May) : Gangtok – NJP

When our time in Gangtok is over we approach NJP and dwell ten rooms for one night.

7) Days - 7 & 8 & 9 (30 & 31/May & 1 June) : NJP - Guwahati

We leave NJP by train at 10:00 p.m because our train is delay from 6:00 p.m to 10:00 p.m. We arrive Guwahati at around 8:00 a.m. 31/May and reside at Mizoram House for two nights.

8) Days - 10 & 11 (2 June & 3 June) : Guwahati - Mizoram

The last two days are used for transferring from Guwahati to Mizoram by Bus and Sumo and finally arrive Aizawl at 5:00 p.m, 03/June.
